

**MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF DISTRICT LEVEL COMMITTEE MEETING, RSVY,
DHEMAJI HELD ON 7TH NOV./2006**

The District Level Committee meeting of RSVY of Dhemaji district was held on 7th Nov./2006 at 11-00 A.M. in the office chamber of the Deputy Commissioner's Dhemaji. The meeting was presided over by Sri Diwakar Nath Mishra, IAS, Deputy Commissioner, Dhemaji and attended by the Hon'ble MLA, Smti Sumitra Doley Patir, Dhemaji LAC, Sri Bhuban Pegu, MLA Jonai LAC, Sri Tulan Konwar, representative of Hon'ble MP, Dr. Arun Kr. Sarmah, 14-Lakhimpur HPC, Dy. Chief Executive Council. SKAC, Chief Executive Officer, MAC, Chief Executive Officer, Dhemaji Zila Parishad, Manager, NABARD and other Departmental Heads of Different Govt. Department of Dhemaji district including President / Secretary of NGOs.

At the very outset the Deputy Commissioner, Dhemaji welcomed all the members present in the meeting. In his welcome addresses, Deputy Commissioner, Dhemaji apprised that, RSVY is a time bound Centrally sponsored scheme and needs proper emphasis and priority for timely implementation. He also informed that the Principal Secretary, Planning and Development Department had impressed upon in the review meeting of RSVY on 3rd Nov/2006 at Dispur that money should be spent in time otherwise district may loose huge amount. So, final recast of the RSVY scheme will be taken up today and no change will be entertained later on.

The scheme-wise discussions held and resolutions were taken as follows :

A) AGRICULTURE & ALLIED SECTOR :

As regards to the scheme of farm mechanization, the Executive Engineer, Agril. Dhemaji informed that the amount sanction in the scheme has been fully utilized and utilization certificate of Rs. 29.79 Lacs. has been submitted. The Chairman instructed to Executive Engineer Agril. to select more beneficiaries for 2nd phase if there is demand.

VETERINARY : As regards to the Veterinary sector the meeting decided to take 40 nos. units instead of earlier 2 (two) units in the Pig Breeding schemes amounting to Rs. 20.26 Lacs. The amount will be utilized by providing Pigs to 40 nos. of SHGs (@ Rs. 50,000/- per SHG). The DVO, Dhemaji will select total 20 Nos. of SHG in Dhemaji and 20 Nos. SHGs in Jonai Sub-Division.

As regards to the scheme of Revolving fund for developing Piggery units and Small pig breeding unit, the DVO, Dhemaji informed that an amount of Rs. 10.00 Lacs received by him and utilized the amount for distribution of pigs etc. to 83 nos. of beneficiaries. Total approved fund for these 2 (two) nos. schemes viz. Revolving fund for developing Piggery unit and Small pig breeding unit is Rs. 30.00 Lacs and Rs. 27.00 Lacs respectively. Out of total Rs. 57.00 Lacs. DVO, Dhemaji has spent Rs. 10.00 Lacs. For remaining Rs. 47.00 Lacs the meeting resolved to change the scheme into Development of Goatery with an amount of Rs. 40.00 Lacs and other Rs. 7.00 Lacs will be utilized in Banana Garden.

As regards to the scheme of the Establishment of Hatchery for promotion of Poultry unit, the meeting proposed to drop the scheme due to non viability and as such the entire approved amount i.e.

Rs. 13.20 Lacs proposed to be implemented in newly taken scheme "Banana Garden". The DAO, Dhemaji will implement the scheme.

As regards to the schemes of Poultry Unit @ 33% subsidy amounting to Rs. 10.00 Lacs the Hon'ble MLA, Jonai suggested the NGOs present in the meeting to select active SHGs for Koiler breeding.

FISHERY :

The District Fishery Development Officer informed that the entire sanctioned amount Rs. 10.00 Lacs for the scheme Fishery in 0.1 Hect. Pound and Rs. 19.55 Lacs for the scheme Development of Derelict Water bodies / wet land etc. in to fishery tank are released to the selected beneficiaries. He also informed that he has already submitted unitization certificate against the whole amount. The Deputy Commissioner, Dhemaji instructed the DFDO, Dhemaji to erect Signboard showing the details of the schemes at the Site.

B) WATER SECTOR :

PHE : The meeting resolved to undertake all the 11 nos of PWSS scheme i.e. "Augmentation of Existing Water Supply Scheme" for implementation. Total amount allocated in PHE Sector is Rs. 70.60 Lacs. In this regard the concerned PHEs are asked to constitute the user committee for bearing of the cost for running the schemes. The Hon'ble MLA, Jonai LAC instructed to the concerned Executive Engineer, PHE, Dhemaji to verify the Plan & estimate before implementation.

D.O. SOIL CONSERVATION :

As regards to the Water harvesting and Mini diversion weir the Chairman expressed his dissatisfaction about implementation of the scheme. The Chairman informed that report received from the Hon'ble MLA, Dhemaji that the D.O. Soil Conservation has received fund from other schemes for implementation of same schemes and hence the matter has been given to Addl. Deputy Commissioner (Dev.) for enquiry.

IRRIGATION : As regards to the earlier approved schemes viz. Installation of STW, 540 nos. and Modernization of existing irrigation schemes the meeting resolved to drop the schemes due to non viability and as such the entire amount of Rs. 50.00 Lacs for installation of STW and Rs. 40.00 Lacs for Modernisation of existing irrigation scheme respectively have been proposed for allotment against newly taken scheme on "Nurse Training Centre" in Dhemaji District and it was also proposed that the NGO, RVC, Akajan will run the scheme on Nurse Training.

C) SERICULTURE & HANDLOOM SECTOR :

SERICULTURE : All the schemes on Sericulture component have been accepted for immediate implementation.

HANDLOOM & TEXTILES : As regards to the setting of Common Facility Center, the meeting proposed to construct only 3 (three) nos. of CFCs out of 6 nos. proposed earlier.

The earlier approved amount of Rs. 10.00 Lacs for the scheme "Providing Dobby Jacquard looms" has been dropped out and the entire amounts is allotted to newly taken scheme "Nurse Training Centre" noted above.

D) INFRASTRUCTURE SECTOR :

PWD (ROAD) : The Supdt. of Police, Dhemaji suggested to improve the roads conditions viz. 1) Moridhal to Dhubabari and 2) Laipulia to Bogibeel alongwith the bridge to be constructed at Gohain Chapori, Bordoloni. The Executive Engineer, PWD Rural & State divisions are instructed to submit the list as early as possible.

ASEB : The Hon'ble MLA, Jonai and Dhemaji suggested to the Executive Engineer, ASEB, Dhemaji to improve the electrification of Jonai Civil Hospital and Gogamukh Hospital in 2nd phase of RSVY.

TOURISM COMPLEX: The meeting resolved to construct all the 3 (three) nos. of Tourism Complexes at Dhemaji near Circuit House, Silapather and Gerukamukh, for these three schemes Rs. 1.30 crores is allotted for 3 years and the amount is earmarked as follows, Dhemaji - Rs. 60.00 Lacs, Silapather- Rs. 40.00 Lacs and Gerukamukh- Rs. 30.00 Lacs.

SHG HAAT : The meeting proposed to construct 6 (six) nos. of SHG Haat viz. at Jonai, Simen Chapori, Silapather, Machkhowa, Bordoloni and Gogamukh out of the allotted amount of Rs. 50.00 Lacs. The meeting has also resolved to ensure the model of the SHG Haats to be similier as Sobansiri Haat, Dhemaji.

As regards to the scheme Bamboo & Cane Plantation the meeting resolved to drop out the scheme due to non viability and the entire approved amount Rs. 30.00 Lacs allotted to newly proposed scheme viz. "Cultivation of Ginger, Turmeric, Black peper and Mustered" etc and DAO, Dhemaji will implement the schemes immediately..

While discussing about scheme for implementation of Bamboo craft production Centre the meeting resolved to drop the scheme due to non viability and the entire amount of Rs. 30.00 Lacs is allotted for "Construction of Girls' Hostel.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks from the Chair.
